The Ministry of External Affairs of Trinidad and Tobago presents its compliments to the Embassy of Switzerland and has the honour to refer to the Embassy's Note of 13th September, 1963.

The Government of Trinidad and Tobago is very grateful to the Government of Switzerland for the grant of scholarships to four students of Trinidad and Tobago and this Ministry very much regrets that a number of factors operated against the earlier selection of suitable candidates who would not have to contend with the language difficulty.

The Ministry is however now in a position to nominate three persons for the academic year beginning 1964 and enquires whether the Government of Switzerland will agree to the award of scholarships to them. They are:

- Miss Jeanette Pollard
- Mr. Lawrence Carrington
- Mr. Trevor Spencer

Miss Pollard who was 22 years old on 1st April, 1963, obtained a First Class M.A. (Hons.) degree at the University of Edinburgh, majoring in Spanish with French as her subsidiary subject.

Mr. Carrington who was 22 years old on 1st March, 1963, obtained a B.A. (Hons.) degree at the University of the West Indies, Jamaica, majoring in French with Spanish as his subsidiary subject.

Mr. Spencer is at present pursuing a course leading to the B.A. (Hons.) degree at the University College of Aberystwyth, Wales, which is expected to be completed in July, 1964. Mr. Spencer is reading for the Joint Honours Course in Geography and International Politics.

The Ministry apologises for any inconvenience caused by this delay in replying to the Embassy's Note under reference and avails itself of the opportunity to renew to the Embassy the assurances of its highest consideration.
