The American Legation presents its compliments to the Federal Political Department and has the honor to refer to an exchange of notes between the Legation and the Federal Political Department regarding the case of Mr. Charles Davis.

The Legation desires once more to mention that Mr. Davis has now been confined to prison for eight months without trial and without formal charges being brought against him. Although the Legation assumes that the necessary dispositions are being taken toward a settlement of this case it would appreciate receiving from the Federal Political Department, as soon as possible, assurances that a solution will be reached in the very near future.

The Legation takes this occasion to renew to the Federal Political Department the assurances of its highest consideration.
