The Ministry of External Affairs & Emigration presents its compliments to the Embassy of Switzerland and has the honour to refer to the Embassy's Note dated 23rd June 1989 requesting for a Warrant of Appointment in favour of Mr. Jean Roland Delaitre to enable the Federal Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Switzerland to submit the candidature of Mr. Delaitre to the Federal Council and to state the following:

/as Mauritius being a member of the British Commonwealth, with Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II/Head of State, the practice regarding the appointment of Honorary Consul of Mauritius is:-

- (a) to submit, by Note Verbale, the name together with the C.V. of the would-be Honorary Consul to the receiving Government requesting the latter to consider the proposal.
- (b) On receipt of the Agrément, the Government of Mauritius starts the procedure for the issue of the Royal Commission of Appointment of the Honorary Consul. The Royal Commission of Appointment is signed by Her Majesty Elizabeth II, Queen of Mauritius and Her Other Realms and Territories and Head of the Commonwealth.

The Embassy would therefore appreciate that the Agrément of the Federal Government of Switzerland is required to enable the Government of Mauritius approach the Foreign and Commonwealth Office in London to prepare the Commission of Appointment of Mr. J. R. Delaitre as Honorary Consul Designate.
