Has been working since 2009 in the CIEN Foundation (Research Institute for Neurological Diseases), attached to the Carlos III Health Institute, as Head of Neuropathology and Scientific Director of the CIEN Tissue Bank. Previously, extensive work as Head of Pathology and Research Director of a University Hospital in Madrid, taking part during this period (1997-2009) in the development of three brain banks in different cities (Madrid, Murcia and Salamanca). During the "mad cow" crisis he was in charge of the neuropathological diagnosis of prion diseases in several regions of Spain, including Madrid, and member of several governmental committees dealing with surveillance and biosafety issues.

He has participated in several research ethical committees and is currently member of the steering committee of the National Platform of Biobanks in Spain. He has received several media awards for the promotion of brain donation.

His research interests are focused on diagnostic and molecular neuropathology of neurodegenerative diseases, biospecimen science and biobanking, and ethical issues related to tissue donation for research. He is author of about 90 original scientific papers, and 5 book chapters.
