Purpose:

The Non-EU Animal Data SOP was written to ensure that Researchers in the HBP and their collaborators in third countries are fully aware that all animal research in HBP is performed in accordance with European laws and regulations.

Key Concepts:

1. Animal research and data ethical issues are addressed through the HBP's standard compliance processes. In a Self-Assessment Survey, PIs are clearly informed that they must not start any research activity requiring approvals unless they have the approvals in place.
2. PIs must submit all ethical permits/approvals. This must be for the duration of their research within HBP, including renewals where applicable. All the ethical permits are collected and kept in the Registry.
3. All PIs and researchers working with animals in HBP should adhere to the 3Rs principles - reducing, refining and replacing - in animal experimentation as stipulated in Directive 2010/63/EU.
4. It is assumed that all PIs are appropriately qualified and have undergone training in LAS (Laboratory Animal Science); have



extensive knowledge and experience in handling of the laboratory animals they work with.

5. It is incumbent upon PIs and their collaborators in third countries to take reasonable steps to avoid redundancy in the experiments in HBP.

Application to HBP Research:

The Non-EU Animal Data SOP is relevant to all animal research in HBP
